The green and gold route markers indicate routes which are part of the National Highway system. They indicate the most direct routes between Perth-Adelaide and Perth-Darwin.

1 National route

The black on white markers indicate those sections of Route 1 around Australia which are not part of the National Highway system.

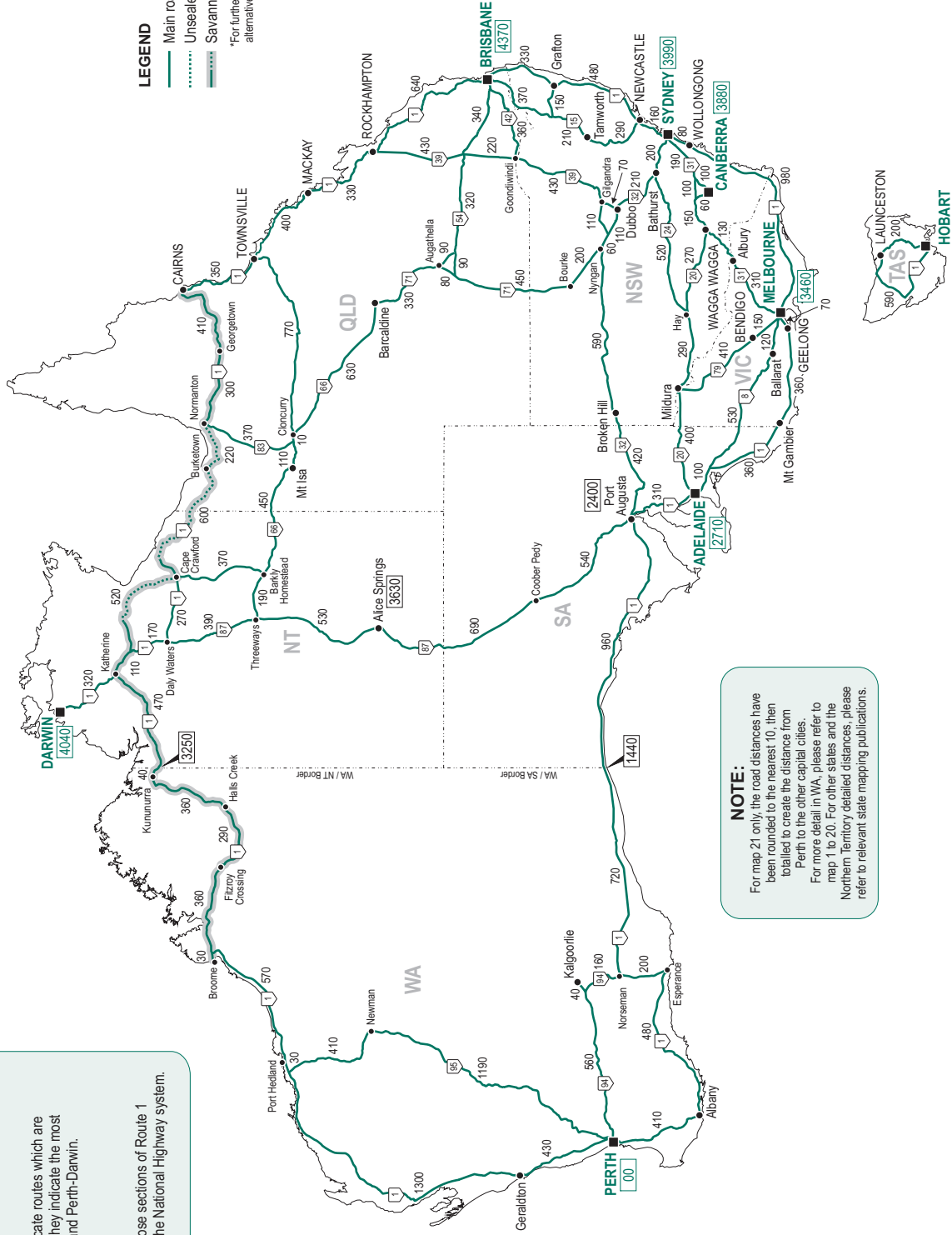
