

About the journey

RAC's Intellibus® ride starts at the eastern end of South Perth Esplanade and heads west along the picturesque South Perth foreshore to the Old Mill. The South Perth foreshore is an iconic tourist destination with views of the Citv's skyline across the Swan River. The sprawling lawns are perfect all year round for people who want to exercise or to simply relax and take in the view. There are picnic tables, BBQ facilities, toilets and four playgrounds on the foreshore. Catamarans, kayaks and stand up paddle boards are also available for hire at the Coode St. Jetty.

Mends Street is the perfect spot to stop for a coffee or bite to eat. The tree lined street has a relaxed village feel that makes it one of the area's most loved destinations.

The Old Mill is one of Perth's oldest landmarks. Built in 1835 and operating until 1859 the mill produced 680kg of flour per day at its peak. Since then, the building has been used as a hotel, a home, a wine saloon and even a poultry farm. It has been restored to its original condition and guided tours are available to the public.
